

## INSTRUCTIONS: Add an APN

If the Access Point Name (APN) of your mobile network operator is not included in the VIU<sup>2</sup> database, VIU<sup>2</sup> will not be able to connect to the mobile network. This can be fixed in a few simple steps:

 Power off VIU<sup>2</sup>, open the left compartment at the back of the camera, remove the modem USB stick and plug it into a Windows computer (Mac OS and Linux are not supported at this moment)



2. An AutoPlay pop-up window will be shown:



3. Click the 'Start Viu2 Tool' to launch the VIU2 Tool:






 Fill in the form with the missing APNs and matching credentials (see below for an example).



2. Add APN to your VIU2 (Leave fields empty if not used)

5. If your SIM requires a PIN then type it in the matching field (please note that your SIM PIN will be disabled). If your SIM does not require a PIN, just leave that field empty.



Click the Save button and wait for a confirmation.



 Unplug the modem USB stick from the Windows computer and insert it back into VIU<sup>2</sup>.



8. Power on VIU<sup>2</sup>, it will connect to the mobile network and register with the server!

## Disable the SIM PIN

Please note that your SIM should not require a PIN for VIU<sup>2</sup> to connect to the mobile network. If your SIM requires a PIN, then you must disable it using the VIU<sup>2</sup> Tool as de scribed above at step 5.
